THEME

MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES IN SUGAR INDUSTRY RESEARCH ORGANISATIONS: THE VALUE PROPOSITION

The Management Commission Workshop will take place during the XXX International Society of Sugar Cane Technologists Congress that will be held in Tucuman in Argentina on 2 – 5 September 2019.

The Workshop will provide ample opportunity for examining the environment in which research is conducted, and not only the manner in which it is conceived and delivered, but also how its quality is ensured and how the outcomes are measured and communicated. Consideration of the modes and rates of adoption of research outputs and an evaluation and assessment of their impact and value will be an integral part of the workshop.

Participants are invited to prepare abstracts related to the theme of the Workshop.

Workshop Format

The formal programme will comprise three workshop sessions, each of which will be preceded by selected oral presentations that will be designed to elicit discussion relevant to the workshop theme. Any proposed presentations that are not selected for oral presentation will be considered as posters.

Abstracts of oral presentations and posters will be distributed to participants at the Workshop.

31 October 2018: Organizing Committee to advise on acceptance of oral presentations and posters.
31 December 2018: Closing date for manuscript submission for posters and papers.
28 February 2019 Closing date for submission of finalised manuscript.
